2016/2017

Federation Subscription rates did not change for non - probationary officers as of the 1st January 2017

2017/2018

Federation Subscription rates did not change for non - probationary officers as of the 1st January 2018

2018/2019

Federation Subscription rates did not change for non - probationary officers as of the 1st January 2019

2019/2020

Federation Subscription rates did not change for non - probationary officers as of the 1st January 2020

2020/2021

Federation Subscription rates increased to £23.58 from 1st September 2020. Therefore, for the year 2020/2021 the figures are as follows: -

5 x £21.58 = £107.90

7 x £23.58 = £165.06

(Total of £272.96)

2021/2022

12 x £23.58 = £ 282.96

2022/2023

Federation Subscription rates increased to £24.31 from December 2022. Therefore, for the year 2022/2023 the figures are as follows: -

8 x £23.58 = £188.65

4 x £24.31 = £97.24

(Total £285.89)

RECRUITS

New subscription rates were introduced with effect from **26th June 2013** for recruits at Year 1 & Year 2 as follows: -

Year 1 – 25% of full rate (rounded up) 12 x £5.42 = £65.04

Year 2 – 50% of full rate (rounded up) 12 x £10.79 = £129.48

Year 1 & Year 2 rates will be at the relevant rate on a pro-rata basis. At the end of Year 2 the subscription amount reverts to the rate relevant at the time. *The above relates to new recruits joining before September 2020.*

Federation subscription rates increased from September 2020 for new recruits joining after this date.

Year 1 – 50% of full rate (rounded up)

2020/2021 (September 2020 – March 2021)

7 x £11.79 = £82.53

Year 1 – 50% of full rate (rounded up)

2021/2022

12 x £11.79 = £ 141.48

Federation subscription rates increased from 1st December 2022 for new recruits.

Year 1 – 50% of full rate (rounded up)

2022/2023

8 x £ 11.79 = £94.32

4 x £ 12.16 = £48.64
